Impact Grant Instructions:

ACCF / Impact Grant

(This is the 10th year for the Impact Grant)

The Adams County Community Foundation (ACCF) is an avid supporter of organizations that serve Adams County residents.

Note: This grant application (and process) is different from the Traditional and Collaborative grant applications and has special criteria. If you plan to apply for less than \$5,000, please use either the Traditional or Collaborative grant application to avoid disqualification.

ACCF mission statement: "Build partnerships between donors and community to enrich and enhance the quality of life in Adams County." Since 1991, we have distributed over \$2 million in scholarships and grants to help build a better community.

Impact Grant

The ACCF will determine how the grant process can best meet the growing demands of our community. One solution is to utilize the concept of an 'Impact Grant'. The ACCF has elected to award multiple grants up to \$15,000. This may be:

- three (3) \$5,000 grants,
- one (1) \$5,000 and one (1) \$10,000 or
- one (1) \$15,000 grant

Acceptable grant applications must meet the following requirements:

- Make a wide-reaching difference / impact
- Have a measurable outcome
- Priority will be given to (but not limited to) collaborations
- Serve several Adams County residents (priority is given to events and programs that serve the broadest range of Adams County residents)

Though other focus areas may be added for subsequent phases* or distributions, in order that the ACCF Grants Committee views this distribution using a similar approach, a ranking / score sheet has been devised. Impact grants will be rated based on the following criteria:

Does this request aim to...

- Serve all of Adams County (or a segmented geographical area)?
- Serve a variety of audiences or demographics (or only a segmented portion of the population)?
- Provide a year-around attraction or does it has a seasonal appeal?
- Have an element of economic development (does it have the potential to grow the economy)?
- Be implemented immediately (or will this be over the course of months / years / etc.)?

*Re: Subsequent Phases. The ACCF Grant Committee may wish to gather more information pertaining to the top scoring Impact grant requests in order to make their final determination. This information can be shared by phone and/or through an interview process. The ACCF will contact the organization(s) approximately 14 days after the grant due date to make these arrangements.
