This application is for students applying for the ACCF / Selking International Trucks Scholarship.

This scholarship opportunity was established to provide financial support for potentially future employees of the trucking industry or Selking International Trucks.

In 1965, Reinhard (Reiney), Mariann Selking, their son Jerry and his wife Wanda established (what is now known as) Selking International Trucks. It has grown considerably in the past 53 years. Reiney passed away in 2016 and today, Reiney's four sons (Jerry, Jim, John, and Joe) share in the ownership of the company.

The company shifted their focus from their agricultural base to the transportation industry in the 1990's and has since evolved into Selking International and Idealease. Selking International Trucks now has eleven locations. These are: eight in Indiana (Decatur, Muncie, Ft. Wayne, Elkhart, Greensburg LaGrange, Richmond & South Bend), one in Michigan (Monroe), and two in Ohio (Toledo and Bryan). Taking care of their customers and their employees has remained their ingredients for success.

Reinhard (Reiney) married Mariann (Brite) in 1944. They are the parents of seven children: Judy (Schiffli), Jerry, Jim, Jeannie (Smith), John, Joann (Okoniewski) and Joe. As of 2024, they had 25 grandchildren and 51 great-grandchildren. Of the 240 Selking International Trucks employees, there are seventeen family members working to continue Reiney's legacy.

Priority is given to students (current or planning) to major in the diesel mechanics field of study. Also considered eligible: applicants that show a connection to the Selking International Trucks & Service group (employee or employee's spouse/child/dependent) majoring in diesel mechanics (priority) or business. Scholarships may be awarded to students seeking two- or four-year degrees or post-secondary vocational training.

The Adams County Community Foundation Scholarship(s) will be awarded through an application process designed to recognize deserving May / June 2025 traditional high school graduates, on-track students, or non-traditional students (see page 3 for definition). Pages must be submitted in this order:
