Eligibility and Student requirements:

Spring 2025: This will be the thirteenth year for this scholarship.

Details of the **Eric Richard Mies Memorial Scholarship Fund** are: Student must:

- + Be an Adams County student or alumni (HS or On-Track, out of High School 1+ years)
- + Have intentions to participate in an exchange, study abroad, educational, or international travel
- + Complete the application process prior to the ACCF due date (date may vary depending upon travel programs associated).

The **Eric Richard Mies Memorial Scholarship** committee will:

- + Review all applications and essays/letters of recommendation of applicants to verify eligibility
- + Make their recommendation to the ACCF Scholarship Committee on scholar(s)
- + The Adams County Community Foundation (ACCF) Scholarship Committee is the final decision maker of this scholar to ensure all IRS and ACCF guidelines have been followed.

It is understood that no family member of the scholarship committee may be a recipient of this scholarship, to consist of: child, grandchild, great-grandchild, to include steps

Brief Award History: In Spring 2024, three scholarships awarded: 1 \$1,000 travel award and 2 \$250 travel awards

Essay Requirements:

Student must submit 1 copy (total) of the essay to the ACCF along with the application and other required materials / Format: max. two pages, double spaced, margins: 1" / font size: 10 min. / 12 max.

- U Author: Applicant's name, high school/college, & anticipated travel destination (top, right corner of essay pg. 1)
- U Essay title: Eric Richard Mies Memorial Scholarship (centered, below author info, top, pg. 1)
- U Due: by **4:00 pm, third Wednesday in April** (late applications will not be considered)

Note to applicant: This essay must be computer generated.

Eric thoroughly enjoyed his travel experiences. This scholarship is intended to memorialize Eric and to promote the excitement and adventure of travel. Knowing that travel can fully influence a person, Eric's family wishes to encourage this experience.

Please address how *you view the importance of travel* by completing **one** of the following topics:

Essay questions:

1. One of Eric's most memorable characteristics was his ability to connect, befriend and maintain contact with people of all cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds. How do you believe that diverse travels and adventures can influence YOUR personality to connect more openly with others?
2. Although Eric's life was cut short, one of his "bucket list" items was to mentor high-school age students interested in international entrepreneurship. His idea conceptualized an organization that would sponsor local entrepreneurship clubs, based on the principles of "think-tank" or "business incubation" centers. Assuming you were to organize and promote a pilot chapter at your school or in your community, how would you encourage cultural diversity and participation?
